“BEING LED BY THE SPIRIT OF GOD #15”

(Notes: How You Can Be Led By The Spirit Of God, Kenneth E. Hagin)

1. Romans 8:14,16 (amp) “For all who are *allowing themselves* to be led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. <sup>16</sup>The Spirit Himself testifies *and* confirms together with our spirit [assuring us] that we [believers] are children of God.” (kjv) “The Spirit itself bearth witness with our spirit...”
  - a) We must allow ourselves, it doesn’t work automatically, be led.
  - b) The Spirit of God testifies & confirms together with our spirit.
  - c) He assure us, we are believers, children of God.
  
2. The Acts 26:19 (amp) “So, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision.”
  
3. The Acts 10:9-11 (amp) “The next day, as they were on their way and were approaching the city, Peter went up on the roof of the house about the sixth hour (noon) to pray, <sup>10</sup> but he became hungry and wanted something to eat. While the meal was being prepared he fell into a trance; <sup>11</sup> and he saw the sky opened up, and an object like a great sheet descending, lowered by its four corners to the earth.”
  - a) Help us Lord to be hungry to pray and seek Your face to know Your will.
  - b) Let our desire for food & drink be secondary to our hunger & thirst for You.
  - c) We can’t pray for trances & see the sky opened up, but they can happen.
  
4. The Acts 10:19-20 (amp) “While Peter was thoughtfully considering the vision, the Spirit said to him, “Now listen, three men are looking for you. <sup>20</sup> Get up, go downstairs and go with them without hesitating *or* doubting, because I have sent them Myself.”
  - a) The Spirit of God through a vision speaks to Peter, (3) men looking for you.
  - b) Go down stairs and go with them.
  - c) Do it with no hesitating or doubting because they are sent by God.

5. The Acts 11:2 (amp) “So when Peter went up to Jerusalem, those of the circumcision [certain Jewish believers who followed the Law] took issue with him [for violating Jewish customs].”
  - a) You can follow the Spirit of God & it put you at odds with the leaders.
  - b) People always want to be a stickler with the law, but God can do a new thing
  - c) Jesus said if they persecuted Me they will persecute us as well.
  
6. The Acts 11:11-12 (amp) “And right then the three men who had been sent to me from Caesarea arrived at the house where we were *staying*.<sup>12</sup> The Spirit told me to go with them without the slightest hesitation. So these six brothers also went with me and we went to the man’s house.”
  - a) When the Spirit of God tells you something you can take it to the bank.
  - b) They even got specific directions by the Spirit of God where to find Peter.
  - c) Peter is rehearsing before the council exactly how it went down.
  
7. The Acts 13:1-2 (amp) “Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets [who spoke a new message of God to the people] and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod [Antipas] the tetrarch, and Saul.<sup>2</sup> While they were serving the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul (Paul) for the work to which I have called them.”
  - a) There were prophets in the church then & are prophets in the church today.
  - b) Their reputation proceeded them, they were not fly by nights.
  - c) They were having special services of praying & ministering to the Lord.
